
Grocery Outlet, Stanwood

LENGTH OF STAY

The last few years have been particularly taxing on animal welfare organizations across the US, CASA included. We see numerous dog surrender requests every week and lack the capacity to take in the requests as they come in. We spent a majority of 2024 with 2-3 week-long waitlists for kennel space. That wait reached 6-8 weeks during peak season. Despite these challenges CASA was able to facilitate 137 dog adoptions in 2024.

The time between dogs entering the shelter system and adoption seems to be increasing every year. Length of Stay is the phrase used to refer to this time period. Our average length of stay for dogs in 2024 was 32 days. Compared to 27 days in 2022 and 2020. Longer length of stays can be taxing on shelter dogs emotionally and can cause behavioral side effects. CASA has been planning and working hard behind the scenes to fight these trends, keep adoptions flowing and advocate for our dogs.

CASA had to get creative. We worked extra hard on marketing adoptable dogs and are still working at finding more effective ways to spread the word about our adoptable dogs. We have a wonderful photographer from Nature side wildlife photography who donates her time to photograph shelter animals. These professional shots provide a great first impression for adopters searching for their new fur friend. Our shelter volunteers have really stepped up and have helped us spread the word through social media, posting photos and videos of our dogs on Nextdoor and Facebook.

Marketing aside, we have been putting our heads together to brainstorm ways to enhance the stay for our shelter dogs. This includes further development of our volunteer program, and improvements to our dog areas. We hope to see shorter length of stay in 2025 and will work diligently to advertise our pets, advocate for adoption and provide excellent care in the meantime.

DOG YARD UPGRADES

CASA is thrilled to announce plans for exciting enhancements to our dog yard and outdoor runs. At the end of 2024 we had revitalized the dog yard with a fresh coat of paint! Our updates will include some enjoyable modifications to improve the experience for our furry friends. We will be replacing the cover over the back dog kennel area. This cover provides shade in the summer and protection from rain in the winter to the outdoor portion of our dog runs. We currently are using a cloth awning material that often tears and needs replacement. We are hoping to replace it with something more durable. We will be researching options and gathering funding.

However, most exciting; CASA will be introducing a sensory and enrichments item to our main play area. If you're not familiar with a dog sensory garden, you're in for a delightful surprise! This garden offers various forms of enrichment for dogs, engaging their senses through sounds like rustling bushes, birds, or music. It stimulates their sense of smell with pet-safe herbs such as lavender, jasmine, and marigold. Additionally, it features a variety of textures and surfaces, including dig pits, grass, platforms, and obstacles. We are still in the planning processes of this project. We hope to have the sensory garden complete and open for our shelter resident's enjoyment by May 2025. Pictured in the first photo on the right is the new paint improvements. The second photo is a current picture of our dog yard and the final picture are some inspiration photos of what a dog sensory yard can look like. Check back with us soon for updates on this project!
